REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
AUGUST 7, 2012**

The Town of Mocksville Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, August 7, 2012 at 4:00 p.m. in the Mocksville Town Hall.

Mayor Slate called the meeting to order.

**Approval of Minutes**

*A motion was made by Commissioner Will Marklin to approve the minutes of July 3, 2012 Regular Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rob Taylor and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Public Comment – None**

*A motion was made by Commissioner Bill Foster to authorize the staff to hold a reception in honor of the Mayor's 90<sup>th</sup> birthday on August 22, 2012 from 3:30 to 5:00 p.m. The reception is in appreciation for all services and contributions Dr. Slate has contributed to the Town of Mocksville and community. *A motion was made by Commissioner Will Marklin to approve the resolution in honor of Lester P. Martin, Jr. and Elizabeth W. Martin. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lash Sanford and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Petition for Annexation – Phillip Fuller, Jr.**

Manager Bralley informed the board of the annexation request from Phil Fuller for 2.037 acres of non-contiguous property.

*A motion was made by Commissioner Will Marklin to approve the annexation request for 2.037 acres for Phil Fuller, Jr. and set a public hearing date for September 4, 2012. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lash Sanford and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Fee Schedule Amendment**

A fee schedule is adopted each year with the budget. A current fee for Itinerant Merchants is \$25.00. Matt Van Hoy, law student intern researched the information and the fee may be \$100 per year. The NCGS also states the Police Department has the right to ask where the goods were purchased and proof of receipt to verify property is not re-sale of stolen goods.

*A motion was made by Commissioner Rob Taylor to approve the fee schedule amendment for Itinerant Merchants. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Richard Broadway and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Manager’s Report**

Manager Bralley informed the board of a letter and certificates that she and the Mayor have received from the North Carolina Army National Guard 882 Engineer Company in appreciation for the town’s support on their send off to their mission in Kuwait.

Code Enforcement is being completed in house with the staff and Public Works Department. Reports are included with agenda.

To date Poplar Street, Railroad Street and Forest Lane have been completed for street preservation and treatment. Commissioner Marklin commented on the article that was in the Davie County Enterprise and stated that John Rhyne with NCDOT was very impressed.

Commissioner Sanford expressed concern about the paving in housing developments. Manager Bralley stated that NCDOT will do city residential side streets based on street condition and traffic volume/flow. Campbell Road is not a city street and will be resurfaced by NCDOT with asphalt. Campbell Road was scheduled by NCDOT prior to the city street preservation and re-treatment surfacing.

Public Works Department removed vegetative debris from Wilkesboro Street and sidewalk and plans to do the same with North Main Street in the following week.

Mayor Slate and Manager Bralley attended the opening of the new line at Avgol. The opening was in conjunction with Avgol’s board meeting with members throughout the world attending. Manager Bralley stated that within all the other plants, China, Russia and Israel, 65% of their sales are generated in Mocksville. The town applauds Avgol as a successful corporate resident and appreciates the employment it provides locally.

A potential buyer for the equipment at Crestwood/Omtron (the chicken processing company) has experienced a fire at another plant and now will not likely be interested in purchasing the equipment.
