The Town of Mocksville Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, October 2, 2012 at 4:00 p.m. in the Mocksville Town Hall.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Commissioner Lash Sanford to approve the minutes of the September 4, 2012 Regular Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Richard Broadway and approved by a unanimous vote.

**Public Hearing – Ordinance to Extend the Corporate Limits of the Town of Mocksville, North Carolina.
Phillip E. Fuller – 980 Salisbury Road.**

Manager Bralley stated that all steps had been taken to extend the corporate limits of the Town of Mocksville for Phillip E. Fuller at 980 Salisbury Road.

Mayor Slate opened and closed the Public Hearing with no one speaking in favor of or in opposition to extending the corporate limits of the Town of Mocksville.

A motion was made by Commissioner Will Marklin to extend the corporate limits of the Town of Mocksville at 980 Salisbury Road. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rob Taylor and approved by a unanimous vote.

CPP Rail Spur Award

Manager Bralley reported to the board that bids were opened for the CPP Rail Spur on September 24, 2012. The lowest bidder was Tar Heel Railroad Construction Co., Inc. at \$467,770.00. CPP Global has hired 100 employees. They now have two (2) shifts.

Attorney Van Hoy stated that the CPP Rail Spur and hiring of 100 people attributed to the great job of the Economic Development of Davie County and the Board.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lash Sanford to approve the bid with Tar Heel Railroad Construction Co., Inc. as the lowest bidder. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Richard Broadway and approved by a unanimous vote.

Manager's Report

Mayor Slate stated that for all commissioners to be thinking of recommendations for a new board member. Mayor Slate also stated that it was very unusual to have two (2) replacements within a year and what a loss it is to this board.
