

**Minutes

The Town of Mocksville Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, July 6, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. in the Mocksville Town Hall.

Mayor F.W. Slate called the meeting to order.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Commissioner Lash Sanford to approve the minutes of the June 1, 2010 Regular Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Will Marklin and approved by a unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lash Sanford to approve the minutes of the June 14, 2010 Budget Hearing. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Will Marklin and approved by a unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lash Sanford to approve the minutes of the June 28, 2010 Special Called Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Will Marklin and approved by a unanimous vote.

PUBLIC COMMENT – No one present to speak

Public Hearing – Text Amendment Sections 4-5.6 and 4-5.7, Pool and Billiard Rooms

Andrew Meadwell explained to the board that the purpose of the text amendment is to clarify the requirements for pool and billiard establishments within the town. Prohibited acts would include the selling, kept, or consumption of any fortified wine, unfortified wine, mixed beverages or spirituous liquors as defined by the NC General Statue on the licensed premises and every employ must have a clean record. The hours of operation shall be no earlier than 10:00 A.M. and no later than 1 A.M.

Mayor Slate opened and closed the public hearing with no one speaking in favor of or in opposition to the proposed text amendment. A motion was made by Commissioner Bill Foster to approve the text amendment to Sections 4-5.6 and 4-5.7 for Pool and Billiard Rooms. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Buster Cleary and approved by a unanimous vote.

Amendment of Interlocal Agreement

The County and Town entered into an Interlocal Agreement in July 2009 providing for shared services, including Communications Services. Manager Bralley introduced an amendment to replace Paragraph 3 of the 2009 Agreement. The amendment states that the County shall provide all radio communications for the Town. Radio communications include, but are not limited to, police, emergency, fire and 911 communications. The Town shall pay to the County

for base communication service the sum of \$45,000.00 from the previous amount of \$95,844.00.

A motion was made by Commissioner Will Marklin to approve the Amendment of Interlocal Agreement with the County of Davie. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Buster Cleary and approved by a unanimous vote.

Manager's Report

Bralley informed the board that the Playground program is currently in progress at Rich Park. The children are served breakfast and lunch at Mocksville Elementary School.

A large crowd gathered for several events held in Mocksville. The Tractor Association had two (2) good days of attendance at the annual Piedmont Antique Tractor Show and parade. Rich Park was parked full for the July 4th fireworks and the July 5th Cruise In was well attended.

Budget Reports are included in the packets.

A Draft for the Comprehensive Transportation Plan Recommendations for the Town of Mocksville has been submitted. A proposed meeting is scheduled for July 15, 2010. The board discussed several issues and concerns with the plan.
