Mayor F.W. Slate called the meeting to order.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Commissioner Will Marklin to approve the minutes of the October 5, 2010 Regular Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Richard Broadway and approved by a unanimous vote.

Comprehensive Transportation Plan

Michael Abuya with the North Carolina Department of Transportation presented to the board an update on the Comprehensive Transportation Plan. The plan recommends widening Interstate 40 from four to six lanes at Dutchman Creek to Hunting Creek; widening US 64 from two to four lanes at Joe Road to John Crotts Road; constructing a 4-lane bypass with median on new location west of Mocksville, widening segments of US 64 from two to three lanes between west of John Crotts Road and US 158, and between US 601 and east of Horseshoe Trail; widening certain parts of US 601 to five lanes; and widening US 158 from two to three lanes at Dutchman Creek to US 64. The plan also includes bicycle lanes, public transportation and rail map and a pedestrian map. The plan will be presented to the board for vote at the December 2010 meeting.

Solid Waste Management Plan Update 2010 – 2020 and Resolution

Joy Howard with Grey Engineering presented the Davie County Solid Waste Management plan update to the board. The update is required of all counties by the State of North Carolina and covers a 10-year timeframe. Davie County's last update was 2003. The plan is a recording tool for government. All local governments are required to be covered by a Solid Waste Management Plan. The goals for the plan are to protect public health and the environment; maintain the solid waste program; reduce waste disposed of by increasing recycling and composting participation; educate citizens on proper ways to dispose of items; and offer user friendly collection services while making recycling and reuse conveniently accessible.

A motion was made by Commissioner Will Marklin to approve the resolution for the 2010 Davie County Solid Waste Management Update. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lash Sanford and approved by a unanimous vote.

NCWATERWARN – Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement for Water and Wastewater Utilities

N.C. Water WARN is a network of water utilities helping each other respond to and recover from emergencies. Manager Bralley told the board if we join we are not required to furnish aid, but if we are able we would do so and other towns and cities would do the same for us.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lash Sanford to approve the NCWATERWARN Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement for Water and Wastewater Utilities. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bill Foster and approved by a unanimous vote.

Manager Bralley informed the board that the Town of Mocksville recently received the completion of Wastewater Collection System Evaluation and Inspection report that is required by the state.
