**Manager's Report**

Manager Bralley informed the board of the codification draft – Part 1 Charter and Related Local Laws. Several chapters will be returned to the board at one time. Board members can look over and make changes as need be. The entire code will be approved at one time. The Code of Ordinances was last approved July 2003 and will continue in the same format.

Bralley requested permission to enter a contract with the Department of Transportation in reference to a mowing agreement. The town currently mows some of the right-of-ways on some DOT streets already. The states' budget will pay a contractor for six (6) cuts per year. Agreement will allow the Town of Mocksville to be reimbursed for six (6) cuts per year.

*A motion was made by Commissioner Buster Cleary to enter a contract with the Department of Transportation for a mowing agreement. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lash Sanford and approved by a unanimous vote.*

A meeting with Department of Transportation has been held also in reference to additional funding for sidewalks. The sidewalks must be connected with a DOT street

An additional meeting was held with Department of Transportation in reference to the maintenance agreement at Interstate 40.

The clarifier at the wastewater Dutchman Creek treatment plant has been repaired. The Public Works Department sandblasted, cleaned and completely repaired the clarifier.
