

**TOWN OF MOCKSVILLE  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
APRIL 2, 2013**

The Town of Mocksville Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, April 2, 2013 at 4:00 p.m. in the Mocksville Town Hall.

Mayor Slate called the meeting to order welcoming everyone in attendance.

**Approval of Minutes**

*A motion was made by Commissioner Rob Taylor to approve the minutes of the March 5, 2013 Regular Board Meeting and the minutes of the March 5, 2013 Executive Session. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Richard Broadway and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Public Comment** – Bob Hall expressed his appreciation of the town and the board members and how beautiful the town looked.

**Public Hearing – Text Amendment Section 4-4 Town Code for Peddling and Soliciting**

The purpose of the text amendment is to expand the section of the Town Code that addresses peddlers, solicitors and transient vendors. There has been an increase in request for mobile vending units and needs to further address them in the Town Code. The text amendment proposes several requirements for both transient vending and transient mobile vending. Transient vending should be considered as any type of push cart that sells food or other items. A mobile transient vendor would be considered any motorized vehicle that sells food or other items such as food trucks.

*Mayor Slate opened the Public Hearing. After some discussion and clarification of the 300 feet of any school, religious institution or cemeteries, Mayor Slate closed the Public Hearing.*

*A motion was made by Commissioner Rob Taylor to approve the Text Amendment Section 4-4 Town Code for Peddling and Soliciting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Richard Broadway and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Contribution of Property – Robert B. Hall and Hope F. Hall to the Town of Mocksville**

Robert B. Hall and Hope F. Hall contributed a piece of property adjacent to the park which is behind their property located at 138 Halander Drive to the Town of Mocksville. This tract is conveyed in memory of their sons, Buck and Stacy Hall. The property will be used only for park and recreational purposes. It will be preserved and maintained in its' natural state except for necessary all weather paths, structures and signs which promote the park/recreational use of the same. Signs are to be erected and maintained naming the tract as "The Buck and Stacy Hall Memorial Wood".

**Residential Garbage Contract**

Manager Bralley stated that it was time to consider a proposal for the garbage contract. The proposed rate is \$7.17 per household per month which is also the current rate. Mark Bacon with Republic Services stated that he was very appreciative of the opportunity to continue to serve the Town of Mocksville.

*A motion was made by Commissioner Lash Sanford to approve the three (3) year contract with Republic Services of North Carolina, LLC. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rob Taylor and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Operations and Management of Dutchman Creek WWTP Contract**

Three (3) proposals have been submitted for the Operations and Management of the Dutchman Creek WWTP contract. The proposals came from Envirolink Inc., Research and Analytical Laboratories, Inc. and the County of Davie.

*After some discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Lash Sanford to accept the contract with Envirolink, Inc. for the management of the Dutchman Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Amy Vaughan-Jones and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Resolution – To Maintain and Support the Current Integrity and Funding for the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (PARTF)**

Manager Bralley informed the board of the resolution for the Park and Recreation dollars that have been matched for years. With the budget concerns with State officials, this particular funding could either be removed or have a lesser opportunity to apply for the funding.

*A motion was made by Commissioner Rob Taylor to adopt the Resolution to maintain and Support the Current Integrity and Funding for the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund (PARTF). The motion was seconded by Commissioner Richard Broadway and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Proclamation – Arbor Day**

Mayor Slate proclaimed April 24, 2013 as Mocksville Arbor Day and he urged all citizens to support efforts to care for our trees and woodlands and to support our city's community forestry program. He also urged all citizens to plant trees to gladden the hearts and promote the well being of present and future generations. The Town of Mocksville has been a Tree City for 20 years.

**Commissioners Report**


Commissioner Vaughan-Jones stated that it was a delight to see Mr. and Mrs. Hall.


