**Public Hearing – Zoning Map Amendment Section 8-3.9.7**

Andrew Meadwell with Davie County Planning and Zoning informed the board of a request to rezone a parcel consisting of 50 acres from Highway Commercial and Flood Plain to General Industrial. The property is located at the end of Theodore Drive and is described as Davie County Tax Parcel H30000008061. Property is owned by William and Kathy Junker. Planning Board has identified this area as a potential industrial type site.

*Mayor Slate opened and closed the public hearing with no one speaking in favor of or in opposition to the Zoning Map Amendment Section 8-3.9.7.*

*A motion was made by Commissioner Amy Vaughan-Jones to approve the Zoning Map Amendment Section 8-3.9.7. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Johnny Frye and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Police Office Recognition – Advanced Certificates**

Manager Bralley congratulated Officer Robin Robbins and Officer Joey Reynolds for their hours of commitment in regards to earning their Advanced Law Enforcement Certificates. Officer Robbins has been with the department for 16 years and Officer Reynolds has been with the department for 5 years.

Officer Reynolds stated that it was an honor to serve the Town of Mocksville and reported that within the department, 12 officers have received their advanced certificates.

**Manager's Report**

Manager Bralley stated that the bed race was a big success. The Chamber tourism dollars and the Mocksville Tourism Development Authority dollars helped support the event. Bralley commended all town departments for all working well together.

Channel 12 / WXII will be showcasing Davie County on December 11, 2013. The News Channel 12 will be broadcasting live from downtown all day beginning with the morning news, noon and evening news. Different segments throughout Davie County will be hi-lighted during the day.

Christmas parade went well and the Police Department controlled traffic very good.

Chuck Willis, engineer will have an update on the status of the state required changes at the Hugh A. Lagle Water Treatment Plant regarding the wastewater in January.

Manager Bralley welcomed Johnny Frye to the board and congratulated Commissioner Vaughan-Jones, Taylor and Sanford on their re-elections.

Daniel Matthews with the Police Department reported that the Toy Drive went very well. He thanked the board for their continued support.

Hank Van Hoy thanked the boards from the past and the present; commenting on previous Commissioner Richard Broadway and thankful for his service.

Mayor Slate stated his appreciation for Commissioner Broadway also.

**Commissioner Report**

Commissioner Vaughan-Jones discussed the fence project at Mando Field.
