The Town of Mocksville Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, April 1, 2014 at 4:00 p.m. in the Mocksville Town Hall.

Mayor Slate called the meeting to order welcoming everyone in attendance.

**Approval of Minutes**

*A motion was made by Commissioner Rob Taylor to approve the minutes of the March 4, 2014 Regular Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Will Marklin and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Public Comment – None**

**Petition for Right of Way and Addition of Public Streets to Town of Mocksville – East Coast Drive**

Andrew Meadwell with Davie County Planning and Zoning introduced a petition of Right of Way and addition of Public Streets to the Town of Mocksville by Cooper Creek Heights. The street complies with standards that are set by the board. The designated street is East Coast Drive. Meadwell suggested that staff recommend accepting the street but would not take into the town's maintenance system until after one (1) year General Contractor's Warranty, with effective date being March 2015.

*A motion was made by Commissioner Lash Sanford to accept the petition for Right of Way and Addition of Public Streets to the Town of Mocksville. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Johnny Frye and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Lease Agreement – Mocs Baseball / Mando Field**

A Rental Use Agreement was presented to the board between the Town of Mocksville and Mocs Baseball. Mocs Baseball is promoting a wood bat baseball league for collegiate eligible players and has requested to use Mando Field. The agreement was prepared by town attorney Hank Van Hoy to include; approximately 20 games from May until July. Scheduling has been confirmed with Rustin Harpe, Parks Director not to conflict with other scheduled activities.

*A motion was made by Commissioner Will Marklin to accept the Rental Use Agreement between the Town of Mocksville and Mocs Baseball. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rob Taylor and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Proclamation – Arbor Day**

*Mayor Slate proclaimed April 4, 2014 as Arbor Day in the Town of Mocksville. The Arbor Day celebration will be held Friday, April 4, 2014 at 11:00 am in Rich Park. Trees will be planted with participation from; Mocksville Elementary students, 4-H Clover Club and the Mocksville Woman’s Club.*

**Proclamation – Child Abuse Prevention Month – April 2014**

*Mayor Slate proclaimed April 2014 as Child Abuse Prevention Month in Mocksville and urged all citizens to engage in activities that strengthen families and communities to provide the optimal environment for children to learn, grow and thrive so that all children have the benefit of happy, healthy and safe childhoods. Sheila Smith, Community Outreach Coordinator with the Dragonfly House was present to speak on behalf of the proclamation.*

**Proclamation – National Healthcare Decisions Day – April 16, 2014**

*Mayor Slate proclaimed April 16, 2014 as National Healthcare Decisions Day. Healthcare Decisions Day is designed to raise public awareness of the need to plan ahead for healthcare decisions, related to end of life care and medical decision-making whenever patients are unable to speak for themselves and to encourage the specific use of advance directives to communicate these important healthcare decisions.*

**Proclamation – National Sexual Assault Awareness Month – April 2014**

*Mayor Slate proclaimed April 2014 as National Sexual Assault Awareness Month. Lori Hayes with Davie Domestic Violence was present to speak on behalf of the proclamation. Teal colored ribbons will be placed on lamp post in the Town of Mocksville to raise awareness of Sexual Assault.*

**Budget Amendment – Baseball**

The purpose of the budget amendment is due to money received for the fence and scoreboard at the Recreation Department. The amendment amount is \$17,035.88.

*A motion was made by Commissioner Rob Taylor to approve the budget amendment for the Recreation Department. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Will Marklin and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Budget Ordinance Revision**

The purpose of the budget revision is for Pro Refrigeration OneNCFund, at no cost to the town. Funding will come from local EDC dollars and the state.

*A motion was made by Commissioner Will Marklin to approve the Budget Ordinance Revision for Pro Refrigeration. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lash Sanford and approved by a unanimous vote.*

**Manager's Report**

Davie County has been declared a state of emergency due to the recent ice storms. NCDOT will have crews removing storm vegetation and debris from state right of ways. Debris will be removed from NCDOT rights of ways inside the city limits. The town's yard waste site has extended hours since the storms and will continue to do so through the month of April. Extended hours are from 8am – 4:30pm M-F. The town has applied for federal funding with an estimate of \$96,000. There is a possibility of some reimbursement. McCoy's Tree Service, has been contracted to clean debris at I-40.

Willis Engineers should have an update on the ongoing projects for the May meeting.

Public Works is in the process of putting valves in water lines in the streets..

A petition has been received for Forest Lane in reference to parking on the streets. Emergency vehicles and garbage trucks have had problems.

**Commissioners Report**

Commissioner Vaughan-Jones thanked the Dragonfly House for their participation in helping with child abuse prevention. She also thanked the Public Works Department for doing a good job.

Commissioner Taylor also thanked the Dragonfly House and Davie Domestic Violence Services.

Commissioner Marklin informed the board of a Forum on the Recreation Bond on April 15, 2014 from 6pm to 8pm. There is a facebook page called Citizens for a Healthier Davie County.

Commissioner Frye requested information on the Explorer Program for the Fire Department.

Commissioner Sanford reported on the Davie County Senior Services Rock-A-Thon. Total amount raised was \$1100.00.
