The Town of Mocksville has entered into a public purpose economic development project authorized under the provisions of NCGS 158-7 with Gildan Yarns, LLC. The project will create 290 new jobs in Mocksville and Davie County and will increase the tax base Mocksville and Davie County by \$142 million dollars. To fund a portion of the economic incentive package, Mocksville proposes to borrow the sum of \$1 million dollars from EnergyUnited Electric Membership Corporation funded by the U.S. Department of Agricultural Rural Economic Development Loan and Grant program. The loan is to be repaid in ten annual equal installment of \$100,000.00 each without interest.

A motion was made by Commissioner Amy Vaughan-Jones to approve the \$1 Million Dollars Interest Free from EnergyUnited Electric Membership Corp. funded by the U.S. Department of Agricultural Rural Economic Development Loan and Grant Program.
